It was a very strange feeling. You made the Segway go by leaning forward, then backwards to go back and to stop you just had to find your centre. Stopping was the more tricky part. I think some of our group found it easier than others, but we all got the hang of it after a bit of practice.

It was good fun weaving in and out of the obstacles practicing, but it was even better when we got to take a tour through the village. You had to be careful of bumps or you might fall off, but no one in my group fell. I loved it best when we went off through the forest on a small path. It was great
