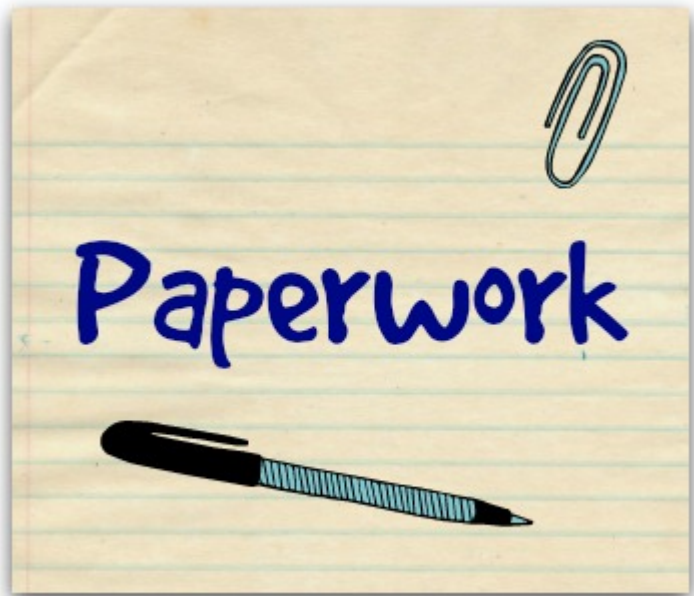


Paperwork
